WHEN: The next tours by Don Price will be September 28, 2007 and October 26, 2007. All tours start at 9 p.m.

WHERE: Greenwood Cemetery, 1603 Greenwood Street, Orlando

WHY: Greenwood Cemetery, established in 1880, is the final resting place of many of Orlando's founding families. Some of the historical families include: Joseph Bumby, Mayor Mahlon Gore, Cassius Boone (Great-Grandson of Daniel Boone), Mayor Capt. James Parramore, Mayor Bob Carr, Mayor Beardall, T. G. Lee, David Lockhart, Samuel Robinson, Mayor Braxton Beacham, Elijah Hand, Carey Hand, Joe Tinker just to name a few.

COST: Free. However, donations to help Greenwood defray costs associated with replacing the 140 trees lost in three hurricanes during 2004 are welcome.
